Our 5 Steps Academic Achievement Success Model!



1. Identify

Review 5th – 12th grade curriculum and common core ELA/Math standards

2. Teach

• Grade level math vocabulary, lessons, videos, and example problems

3. Practice

• Grade level math printable worksheets, textbooks, and workbooks

4. Demonstrate Mastery


Grade level math practice test and games

Step 1: Educational Evaluation and Diagnostic Learning Assessments

- Through the assessment process we identify students' academic strengths and weaknesses and explain how these underlie academic struggles
- We administer a standardized achievement test to provide grade equivalents and percentiles in ELA and math.
- We use our own math and reading placement exam to gain an understanding of your child's computational and problem solving ability. For high school students, we administer a study habits evaluation.



Step 3: Analysis and Recommendations

- Before revealing the results of assessments with our parents, we spend considerable time analyzing the assessment to gain an understanding of the results.
 Because each of our students produces a unique assessment profile we carefully use our findings to refine our analysis.
- Based on our analysis of the test, we develop a customized learning plan (prescriptions) that we share with our parents.

Step 4: Learning Strategy Plan

- Learning Strategy Plan, which is a broad outline of the subjects on which we will work, as well as the curriculum items we will use.
- We present our estimate of the program duration and, together, we develop a tutoring schedule and payment plan that meets your child's and family's needs.

Step 5: Academic Coaching Match-up

- Our Educational Director will develop your child's academic coaching program from the Learning Strategy Plan we shared with parents during the evaluation meeting. Our approach is to begin instruction at levels that will insure success.
- The goal is to give our student a sense of accomplishment a sense of "I can achieve." As he or she experiences success, we increase difficulty level so there is an increased sense of challenge. It's a delicate balance, developing enthusiasm, while insuring real skill development.

Step 6: One-to-One Learning

- All lessons are conducted in an environment where the student is most comfortable, usually at home or library. We feel that the most productive learning occurs in a one-to-one atmosphere so that no student becomes lost in the crowd of a classroom.
- Individualized tutoring ensures that students maintain their concentration throughout the lesson and are given the opportunity to ask the questions that matter to them. The one-to-one lessons enable tutors to constantly monitor the student's progress and adjust the course of study as necessary

Step 7: Academic Progress Consultation/Interim Follow-up Meetings

- We schedule frequent evaluation meetings with our parents to discuss best practices and our unique approach academic achievement. During our meetings, we discuss the goals we have set and what your child has achieved.
- We'll discuss the successes, as well as the challenges that both you and we face. While each meeting duration will depend on the topics and your questions, typically they each last about one-half hour.

Step 8: School Advocate (optional)

By working together with the school, we can collectively provide the attention and guidance your child deserves. With your permission, we will call or visit with your child's teachers and guidance counselors to keep them informed of his or her progress and areas of need.
